ABOUT THIS MEDICATION

What the medication is used for:
Temporary relief of mild to moderate migraine headaches including associated symptoms of nausea, and sensitivity to light and sound.

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What it does:
Advil Liqui-Gels (buprofen) is a nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drug (NSAID) that can reduce the chemicals produced by your body which cause pain and

- When it should not be used:
 Do not take Advi Liqui-Gols if you have or are:

What the medicinal ingredients are: Ibuprofen (present as free acid and potassium salt).

What the important nonmodicinal ingredients are: FDRC green no. 3, getatin, tecithin (soy), medium chain triglycerides, pharmaceutical ink, polyethylene glycol, potassium hydroxide, purified water, sorbtan, sorbtol.

What dosage forms it comes in:
Each liquid filled capsule contains ibuprofen 200mg (present as free acid and potassium self).

WARNINGS AND PRECAUTIONS

Serious Warnings and Precautions

BEFORE you use Advil Liqui-Gels talk to your doctor or pharmacist if:

INTERACTIONS WITH THIS MEDICATION

- Do not use Advil Liqui-Gels if you are taking:

PROPER USE OF THIS MEDICATION

Usual dose:

For migraine headaches: Adults and children 12 years and over. Take 1 (every 4 hours) or 2 (every 6-8 hours) Liqui-gels at the first sign of symptoms as needed. Do not exceed 6 Liqui-gels in 24 hours, urless directed by a doctor.

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Overdose:

In case of overdose, call a Poison Control Centre or a doctor immediately, even if there are no symptoms.

Missed Dose:
Take the missed dose as soon as you remember, if it is almost time for your next dose, wait until then to take your medicine and skip the missed dose. Do not take two doses at the same time.

SIDE EFFECTS AND WHAT TO DO ABOUT THEM

Take with food or milk fuguest stomach occurs.
